

Keeping Your 24 Month Old Safe

Toilet Training

Your child may sometimes be using the potty or toilet. Remember to praise and reward this behavior, but never to punish toilet accidents in any way.

Outdoor Play

Always supervise your toddler outdoors. Your child does not understand traffic safety even if they nod “yes” when you give them instructions. Your 2 year old does not remember your rules while playing and exploring.

Tricycles & Bicycles

Teach your child to always wear a bike helmet when riding.

Be a good role model by always wearing your helmet too!

An adult must always be with your child during outdoor activity.

Do not let your child ride a tricycle/bike or play in the street.

Walk behind your car before you back out of your driveway to be sure your child is not behind your car. You may not see your child through the rear view mirror.



Car Seats

If your toddler has outgrown the weight or height limit of their car seat, they can now ride in a forward-facing car seat with a harness that's in the back seat of the car.

Use this rule with your child(ren) - the car only moves when everyone is wearing their seat belt.
